Benefits Counseling is a service of Work Without Limits that assists individuals with disabilities who receive Social Security Disability Insurance (SSDI) and/or Supplemental Security Income (SSI), who are looking for employment or are currently working, to understand how work earnings or wage increases impact these and/or other public benefits.

SERVICES

CWICs:

The Benefits Counseling team consists of certified Community Work Incentives Coordinators (CWICs) who possess extensive experience in both employment and public benefits.

- Help individuals understand how working and earning wages will affect public benefits
- Provide ongoing assistance to help individuals manage their benefits as they transition into employment or increase their earnings
- Provide information on available education, training, and employment services
- Assist in the development and implementation of Plans to Achieve Self-Support (PASS) and identify other work incentives that can assist individuals achieve their employment goal

COVERAGE AREA

We provide benefits counseling to Massachusetts residents residing in Berkshire, Franklin, Hampden, Hampshire, Middlesex and Worcester counties.

We also provide benefits counseling to New York residents residing in Albany, Columbia, Greene, Rensselaer, Schenectady, Schoharie and Washington counties.
