Hospital Rate Setting

• FY21 rates have been reviewed and finalized.

HSN Regulation Updates

- HSN is in the process of proposing changes to the 101 CMR 613.00 and 614.00 regulations.
- These updates along with a public comment period have been posted to the HSN website.

CHC Reprocessing

- HSN conducted takebacks in January 2021. HSN will have another takeback tentatively scheduled for March 2021.
 - January 2021
 - CHC Secondary Over and Underpayments
 - March 2021 (tentative)
 - Price adjustments for J7296, J7297, J7298, and J1050
 - Removal of J7301



COVID-19 Vaccine Billing

- Providers should bill the Health Resources and Services Administration (HRSA) for the COVID-19 vaccine for MassHealth Limited members and Health Safety Net patients without other coverage.
- Providers are responsible for checking the Eligibility Verification System (EVS) for MassHealth eligibility and other sources to determine whether a patient is insured.
- Providers should submit their claims for COVID-19 vaccine administration to the HRSA Portal for Uninsured Individuals at https://coviduninsuredclaim.linkhealth.com/.



COVID-19 Testing/Treatment Billing

- Providers should bill HRSA for COVID-19 testing and treatment of Health Safety Net patients without other coverage. Testing and treatment for MassHealth Limited members should not be billed to HRSA.
 - COVID-19 testing and treatment services provided to an individual in the Children's Medical Security Plan only, and who does not have any coverage (including MassHealth Limited), should be billed to HRSA.
- Providers should submit their claims for COVID-19 testing/treatment to the HRSA Portal for Uninsured Individuals at <u>https://coviduninsuredclaim.linkhealth.com/</u>.

Interim Payment Reconciliation: CHCs

- Interim payment recovery began with the August 2020 pay cycle.
- During interim payment recovery, a provider's monthly payment will be reduced by a calculated recovery amount to reflect the payments made during interim payment periods.
- For each recovery month the interim payment recovery amount is determined by comparing a provider's monthly demand based on claims submitted to MassHealth, POPS (for pharmacy claims), or DentaQuest (for dental claims), and the monthly interim payment balance.
- The HSN will continue with the recovery formula until the entire interim payment balance has been recovered.



Important

- Please note that the HSN is the payer of last resort for Acute Care Hospitals and CHCs.
- Providers are encouraged to review the Populations Exempt from Collection Actions section of 101 CMR 613.08(3) and contact the HSN with any questions they might have.

- Please submit any claims prior to September 1st, 2020 as soon as possible.
 - As of February 17th, there are 266 days until September 30, 2021.
